Overview:

This document was prepared to give a general overview of the background and general operation of CSES, as well as contacts and duties of the Executive Director.

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Background of CSES:

(Formerly JCCS- Job Connect College Sector)

The JCCS organization was formed in the fall of 2002 and was named JCCS- Job Connect College Sector. Prior to JCCS being formed colleges who delivered the MTCU provincial program Job Connect worked independently, had no collective voice in Toronto with MTCU, and no linkages between colleges to share ideas, expertise or meet regionally. The colleges decided as a group to hire an Executive Director to represent all colleges delivering the Provincial Program Job Connect. This brought the group together as a cohesive organization and began to increase their profile in the province as well as internally in the college system.

In the summer of 2007 all college managers who deliver EAS programs for MTCU (Employment Ontario) joined the sector. EAS program deliverers had come over to the province from the Federal Government as part of the new Employment Ontario program. As a result, the organization felt a new name which would be more inclusive was needed. CSES – College Sector Employment Services was the new name chosen by the expanded membership and as of September of 2008 formally took on the new name. CSES Terms of Reference can be found in the following pages.

CSES took on a new Logo as well which was designed by a St. Lawrence college design student.

CSES is the provincial college representative committee to the Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Development (MAESD) (formerly Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities). Its role is to be the united voice to the Ministry to initiate change or improvements to the Employment Service program. The operating costs of CSES are supported by the provincial colleges.

TERMS OF REFERENCE

College Sector Employment Services

MANDATE

The College Sector Employment Services (CSES) will represent the Ontario college system in the development and/or delivery of contracted employment support services within a framework of continuous improvement, outcomes-based management and accountability.

TERMS OF REFERENCE

The College Sector Employment Services, hereinafter called the CSES will maintain formal links with the following organizations:

All College Employment Ontario deliverers in Ontario
Workforce Development Coordinating Committee (WDCC)
Colleges Ontario (CO)
Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Development (MAESD)
College Sector Committee for Adult Upgrading (CSCAU)
Heads of Apprenticeship (HAT)

Relationships

- CSES reports to Colleges Ontario and the Committee of Presidents through the WDCC.
- WDCC will identify one staff person as the official CSES contact.
- The CSES Chair or Executive Director will liaise with the Chair of the CSCAU and HAT
- The CSES Chair or Executive Director will represent CSES at CO, MAESD, and WDCC regularly scheduled meetings.

Objectives

CSES is a sub-committee of Colleges Ontario reporting through the Workforce Development Coordinating Committee (WDCC) to carry out the following:

1. Provide informed advice to government based upon the views of the CSES organization
2. Lobby and influence related government initiatives at the provincial level

3. Enhance communication between CSES and MAESD, sharing information with College/MAESD working and advisory groups and developing common positions on issues
4. Make recommendations through WDCC and CO to the Committee of Presidents on province-wide operational and administrative issues
5. Consider, investigate and report on matters referred to it by the WDCC and MAESD
6. Develop recommendations, within the college system, in support of the effective and efficient management of college resources in support of program initiatives
7. Solicit formal input from the membership on decisions affecting the planning, organization, direction, control, marketing, and implementation of existing and potential services and programs
8. Represent provincial and regional college interests by identifying, analyzing and placing priorities on issues/concerns
9. Co-ordinate and manage CSES development projects on behalf of the College Sector
10. Co-ordinate and conduct research and analysis on key provincial issues on behalf of the College Sector
11. Support and facilitate the professional development and professionalism of delivery staff
12. Educate the public and key stakeholders about the economic and social benefits of addressing the employment needs of the people of Ontario, and advocate the provision of services to meet those needs
13. Collect information which illustrates the strategic value of CSES operations in our colleges and in our communities
14. Build and maintain relationships with MCI and MCSS, MCYS and Service Canada
15. Review the CSES terms of reference annually.

CSES Committee

Membership

- Each college who delivers Employment Ontario Employment Services will identify at least one manager to represent that college on the Regional and Provincial Working Groups. These representatives communicate within their college and with members of the Regional and Provincial Working Groups. They are responsible for supporting activities undertaken by CSES.

Executive Director

- As funds permit, an Executive Director will report to the Executive and operate on its behalf. The Chair and Executive Director shall meet or hold conference calls regularly. A contract with the Executive Director will be prepared by the Executive and reviewed by the Chair and ED annually.

Executive

- A Chair and Vice Chair shall be selected from the nine-member Executive by members of the Executive and shall have a term of two years. The position of past Chair will be used to assist the Executive as required. The Vice Chair will become Chair at the end of the two-year term.
- The Vice Chair shall assume the position as Chair of the CSES training committee for the two-year Vice Chair term. Members shall determine the number, makeup, and duration of committee members as required but shall have all four regions represented on the committee. *(addition Sept. 2010)*
- The four regions (North, Central, West and East) shall provide two representatives each and the full membership shall provide one francophone representative. These nine members shall form the CSES Executive along with the Executive Director. The review of who represents each of the four regions and for how long will be the responsibility of each region.
- Members are expected to commit sufficient time and energy to achieve the defined responsibilities.

Ex Officio Members

- From time to time, working groups may be struck to develop projects. These groups are normally task-specific with less than a one-year term and are disbanded at the end of the project. Representatives of these groups will be ex officio members of CSES.
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Minutes

- Minutes are to be distributed as follows:
 - All college managers of CSES
 - WDCC contact
 - Field staff as determined by CSES Managers

Meetings

- CSES Executive meetings will be held quarterly at a minimum either by teleconference or face-to-face at the discretion of the Executive.
- At a minimum, two full membership meetings will be scheduled for all College CSES Managers. At the spring meeting the new Chair selected by the Executive will be confirmed by the membership and a financial report and update of CSES activities will be presented by the Chair and ED.
- The agenda shall be prepared prior to meetings and be distributed with any supporting documentation to all members whose attendance is requested.
- Regional college CSES managers will meet quarterly at a minimum either by face-to-face or conference call at the discretion of the members. Regional Chairs are responsible for setting the agendas and arranging for minutes to be taken. Minutes will be forwarded to the CSES Chair and ED.

General Duties of the Executive Director:

- Report to the CSES Executive on a regular basis (minimum of four times annually) and arrange the meeting and minutes.
- Represent CSES at college, provincial and ministry meetings such as WDCC.
- Organize two annual general membership meetings and provide a written report of activities as well as a financial statement at the meeting including minutes.
- Ensure that CSES has a high profile with MAESD as well as internally in the college system.
- Make connections with MAESD as well as MCI and MCSS.
- Attend regional conferences of CSES members and where appropriate deliver workshops (such as apprenticeship, LMI, employment related).
- Represent CSES on MAESD and provincial committees such as the Manager' Forum steering committee
- Ensure sharing of information from provincial sites/managers with other college sites across the province to improve best practices and provincial organizational capacity.
- Work with HAT and CSCAU to improve profiles of all three organizations within the college as well as improve each other's understanding of operations, guidelines, and referrals.
- Write reports, newsletters, bulletins as required.
- Attend regional CSES manager meetings when possible.
- Set up and maintain CSES financial process with the College handling the CSES budget. All CSES invoicing will be managed by the Executive Director, with payments going into the CSES bank account handled by the said College.
- Be a voice of common interests and issues of CSES at Ministry and college meetings and functions as well as a point of contact.
- Attend WDCC meetings on a routine basis (four times per year) supplying a report to them on CSES activities and issues to be taken to Colleges Ontario.
- Work on behalf of CSES with Colleges Ontario.
- Set up and maintain a CSES website.
- Promote/organize PD within the CSES organization. Examples include workshops for staff and managers and webinars for staff and clients.
- Prepare an annual report on targets and funding for the entire CSES organization both individually, as well as by region and provincially.
- The ED attends other random committees on behalf of CSES as felt suitable by the Executive.

Finance:

Funds of CSES are held by a Community College. Currently it is St. Clair College.

The operating costs include the Executive Director's time, travel, phone, space rental and any other miscellaneous expenditures incurred in carrying out the duties of CSES (i.e. supplies). The Executive Director is paid bi-weekly by St. Clair College for hours worked. The Executive Director will complete an expense claim form for out of pocket expenses on a monthly basis and mail/courier to St. Clair College, along with original receipts.

Membership fees are paid by each College member on an annual basis. Colleges pay a set membership for their first location and an additional reduced membership for each additional site, up to a maximum of 5 sites total. Membership is reviewed annually by the Executive and membership.

The following points outline the process:

1. The Executive Director will initiate and email invoices to the provincial colleges for their share of the operating costs on April 1st of each calendar year.
2. The Executive Director will ensure that copies of all invoices are shared with St. Clair College for audit purposes.
3. An honorarium in the amount of \$1,000 is paid by CSES to St. Lawrence College for space rental, access to computer, phone, printing and copying.
4. The Executive Director and St. Clair College will meet regularly for a budget update.
5. St. Clair College will administer the CSES budget and will support the reporting structure to the membership on a semi-annual basis.
6. St. Clair College will be reimbursed the amount of their membership fees to financial services rendered and audit requirement on an annual basis.
7. In the event of additional funds being awarded to CSES, St. Clair College will administer these also, through their normal financial services process.
